## ARTICLE 3 - PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

- 3.1 The Association, as the exclusive representative of all Bargaining Unit Members in the bargaining unit, will represent all such Bargaining Unit Members. Membership in the Association shall be made available to all who apply, consistent with the Law.
- 3.2 Accompanying all deductions paid to the Association shall be an alphabetical list of Bargaining Unit Members for whom such deductions have been made.
- 3.3 Upon appropriate written authorization from any Bargaining Unit Member, the Board shall deduct from Bargaining Unit Member's salary and make appropriate remittance for annuities, credit union, savings bonds, charitable donations or any other new plans or programs jointly approved by the Association and the Board.
- 3.4 The District shall rely on information provided by the Association regarding deductions for membership dues including cancelations or charges. All authorized payroll deductions will be mailed no later than the tenth (10th) working day of any payroll month.
